Greetings Mr. Anderson,

This is to confirm that we visited your home this evening to present you with a petition against privatization of postal services (with over 1,000 signatures), and a folder detailing the <u>waste</u>, <u>fraud and corruption in the HCR contract #970L2</u>. Your son, Chase, and wife, Cheryl, met us at the door and received the petitions and folder on your behalf.

As we explained to your wife and son, we were forced to bring our concerns directly to your home because you have refused our efforts to meet with you at your office on the third floor of the Main Post Office at 715 NW Hoyt in Portland.

For the past ten months, we have sought a meeting with you -- and other postal managers Erica Brix, Brenda Jackson & Lisa Shear -- through local union presidents (APWU, NALC, NPMHU – August 7, 2013), through Congressional representatives (August, 2013), and by arriving with groups of concerned citizens (July 26, September 18, and October 29, 2013). We have received four rejection letters from your assistant, Michael Norbom.

We again urge you to drop the contracting-out of postal trucking, specifically the mail runs between the processing plants in Portland. The current subcontract with Dill's Star Route/LAPO trucking expires June 30, 2014 and is about to be renewed for four years. Not only does the HCR #970L2 eliminate about ten union, postal jobs, it is hugely wasteful, fraudulent and corrupt.
